### **HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2017**

- The Ethics Committee reviewed an 'item analysis' for post-test questions provided to us from the Executive Director, regarding the online Ethics and Jurisprudence Course, sponsored by Chapter.
- The Ethics Committee submitted an additional set of questions to post-test 'item bank' for the course, to the Chapter President, for review by Course Web designer, for the remaining period of licensee cycle.
- On behalf of the Chapter, Renee VanVeld will present the Ethics component of the Course 'live' for the Annual Fall meeting of the Indiana Chapter, on October 28th, 2017.
- The Ethics Committee received one inquiry this calendar year regarding a potential Code violation. The Committee analysis, in return, suggested need for further fact-finding. No further action undertaken.

### PROJECTIONS FOR REMAINDER OF 2017 AND 2018

• The Ethics Committee may wish to consider (i.e., expand) its education and consultative functions; in view of the revision of the Disciplinary Action Procedural Document by the APTA, that reduces the burden on the Committee's involvement regarding member violations in Indiana.
