APTA Indiana is Seeking Proposal Submissions for the 2022 APTA Indiana Fall Conference scheduled for October 21-22, 2022 (sessions held on Saturday, October 22) in Fort Wayne, IN. Proposals for 1.5-, 3-, and 6-hour educational sessions are now being accepted. 6-hour sessions should include a lab. Proposal submission deadline is **May 20, 2022**.

The theme for this year's conference is "Innovation." The conference will focus on how we, as therapists, can continue to transform society, reduce healthcare costs, and improve Hoosiers' overall health by optimizing and encouraging movement.

In addition to innovative clinical topics, we are also seeking proposals on the following:

- Programming Specific to PTAs
- Programming Specific to Student PTs and PTAs
- Management
- Nontraditional Practice and/or Payment Models (cash practices, direct to employer contracting, value-based care, wellness/prevention models, Annual PT exam)
- Documentation

Proposal Submission Information:

Proposal submissions for educational sessions must contain the following:

1. Title
2. Course Description
3. Course Objectives
4. Recommended Participant Level
5. Speaker Information
 - Name
 - Credentials
 - Institution
 - City/State
 - E-Mail
6. Brief Bio (150 words or less) and CV for Each Speaker
7. Head Shot

Important Things to Remember When Submitting Your Proposal:

1. Speaker information will appear exactly as submitted in all publications, both in print and online. Please ensure the accuracy of this information before finalizing your submission.
2. Please indicate if your proposal is for a 1.5-hour, 3-hour or 6-hour (w/lab) educational session.
3. Selection of proposals will be based on the foundation in evidence, clarity of proposal, probable interest to participants, fiscal feasibility, and space and time constraints.
4. Proposals should reflect cultural and/or ethical components related to clinical practice and research as related to session content.
5. Proposals should be devoid of any promotional content.
6. An honorarium of \$100 per speaking hour and mileage reimbursement will be offered to accepted speakers. One night's hotel stay will be reimbursed at the conference hotel for speakers traveling over 60 miles (each way) to the conference.
